Building healthy, faith-based caring communities

Our mission is to provide excellence in care, shelter and support in a nurturing Christian environment for all entrusted to our care.

Licensed by the Province of Saskatchewan and accredited by CARF, LutherCare's intermediate care homes offer a safe, secure, family-style environment.

What is intermediate care?

LutherCare's intermediate care homes serve seniors who can no longer live on their own, but who do not qualify for admission to a subsidized special care home. This level of care is often referred to as Level 1 and 2 care. Our homes are licensed as personal care homes by the Province of Saskatchewan.

Located within, or adjacent to, our seniors' housing developments, the homes support the LutherCare "continuum of living" by allowing residents to stay in familiar and supportive environments, near to their loved ones, even as their needs change. They aim to provide comfortable, family-style living.

Admission to the intermediate care homes is controlled by our own LutherCare staff. First priority is given to residents of the seniors' housing development where the home is located, second to residents of other LutherCare facilities, and third to people from the community.



Four locations

Luther Heights ICH

- Located at 1904 Alexandra Avenue on same lot as Luther Heights
- 15 rooms, each with private bath

Luther Riverside Terrace ICH

- Located within Luther Riverside Terrace
- 20 singles' rooms and 4 rooms suitable for singles or couples

Luther Tower ICH

- Located at 1230 Temperance Street across the road from Luther Tower
- 15 rooms

LutherCare Village at Stonebridge

- Located at 250 Hunter Road within LutherCare Village
- 27 rooms, each with private bath



Program features

LutherCare's Intermediate Care Homes serve seniors who require extra support to maintain their independence. Services include:

- 24/7 care
- Nutritious meals
- Housekeeping
- Laundry
- Personal hygiene assistance
- Medication management
- Spiritual Care
- Social and recreational activities
- Respite care
- Assistance with appointments and transportation
- Family participation encouraged
- Professional social worker
- Wellness clinics
